

Getting Your Motorcycle License Is Easy!

The Maryland Motor Vehicle Administration sponsors many classes throughout Maryland to quickly and easily get your motorcycle driver's license. Almost all of Maryland's Community Colleges teach Motorcycle Safety classes. The classes are simple; attend two evening classroom sessions and then two weekend riding sessions. If you pass the class, you are given a letter to take to the MVA and have a motorcycle endorsement added to your existing Driver's License. You do not need to take a test or even get a Learner's Permit at the MVA! Motorcycles are provided at the class and helmets if you need to borrow one. The class costs between \$280 and \$350 to take, but Battley Cycles will take the cost of the class off your invoice at the time of purchase when you buy a new motorcycle from us within 30 days of passing your class! Here are the educators Battley Cycles works with in Montgomery County. We have agreements with these organizations and a Battley Cycles Salesperson can help get you registered for a class right away!



Montgomery College is a less expensive alternative but they typically have a wait list to get into a class. Battley Cycles can help with that, but it may not be as fast as you like. Classes are held Wednesday and Thursday nights at the Technology Center in the heart of old town Gaithersburg. Riding sessions are held in a parking lot near Clopper Rd and Rt 124 in Gaithersburg. Classes are typically \$290.
